Books on Rails Delivery Service Policy

Books on Rails is a service designed to assist homebound citizens of Washburn County who are 60 or older. If you are younger than 60 or have temporary home delivery needs, please contact the library director at 715-635-2792 for assistance.

Books on Rails recipients must reside in Washburn County.

Reading material is selected using the Books on Rails Book Matching Form, an online database, and the expertise of the library staff. We are able to best match books if given a specific title or author. As a library we will do our best to meet customer expectations, but we are not ultimately responsible for ensuring you will enjoy all our selection. We will keep track of the books you read only for the purposes of preventing double orders.

Books will be delivered at least once a month by Faith in Action volunteers with options of more frequent deliveries and pick-ups if volunteers are able. Volunteers donate their time, and provide their own vehicles and gas.

Please make sure that volunteers have convenient and safe access to your home. Also, please make sure books are returned in the same condition they were when first received. You will be billed directly for any items returned not usable.

Please do not call the volunteers or Faith in Action regarding this service. Please call the library directly for Books on Rails related matters.

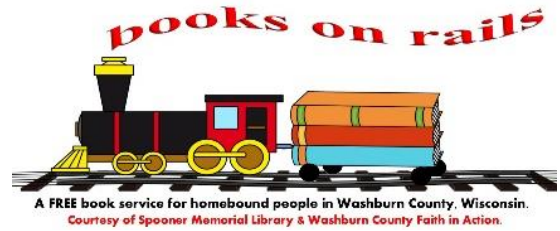
If the stipulations of this policy are not met, the library reserves the right to discontinue Books on Rails service.
