

WHO TOOK THE SURVEY


On average, how often do you visit the library? 50 responses










- Spooner Library is the best community library I have seen, wouldn't change a thing!

- > I like my library very much. I don't know what I would do without it.


THINGS TO WORK ON (LIBRARY SERVICES)

- > Earlier morning hours.



- ➤ Love it now!


THINGS TO WORK ON (LIBRARY COLLECTIONS)

- ➤ More non-fiction.





- > The library brings all ages together, with education.


HOW DOES THE LIBRARY BENEFIT THE COMMUNITY?
